Fundamentals of Passivhaus

Construction for Passivhaus, 1st – 2nd June

Two half-day sessions delivered through webinar

Building Services for Passivhaus, 8th – 11th June

Delivered over 4 half-day sessions through webinar and interactive exercises.

PHPP, 16th – 19th June

Delivered over 4 half-day sessions through webinar and practice sessions using the software.

Revision, 23rd and 24th June

Two half-day sessions delivered using a mix of webinar, self-learning and tutorial support time.
