### **Construction for Passivhaus, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> June**

Two half-day sessions delivered through webinar.

### **Building Services for Passivhaus, 15<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> June**

Delivered over 4 half-day sessions through webinar and interactive exercises.

### **PHPP, 23<sup>rd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> June**

Delivered over 4 half-day sessions through webinar and practice sessions using the software.

### **Revision, 29<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> June**

Two half-day sessions delivered using a mix of webinar, self-learning and tutorial support time.

### **Introduction session, 22<sup>nd</sup> May**
